DIRECTIVE REACH No. 1907/2006 – Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) Candidate List updated February 2026 – 253 substances

The European Commission established the Regulation on chemicals called REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals), which entered into force on 1 June 2007, including subsequent updates.

All substances manufactured and/or imported into the Member States in quantities exceeding 1 ton per year, whether supplied as substances, in mixtures or in preparations, must be registered in accordance with this European Regulation. To qualify for the transitional periods provided by REACH, all substances meeting the above requirements had to be pre-registered by 1 December 2008.

Giovenzana Trasformazioni G.G.T. Srl is not subject to registration of its products because:

- The company's products are articles as defined in REACH and not substances or mixtures containing substances intended to be released;
- The company does not manufacture or import from non-EU countries chemical substances as such or in mixtures that would require registration under REACH;
- The company assembles articles that, under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use, do not release substances;
- The articles supplied by Giovenzana Trasformazioni G.G.T. Srl do not contain Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) above the threshold of 0.1% (w/w) as defined in the current REACH Candidate List.

Giovenzana Trasformazioni G.G.T. Srl, in order to ensure proper compliance with all obligations under REACH Regulation, continuously cooperates with its suppliers in collecting information and performing the necessary checks regarding the registration status of chemicals and preparations used in their activities.
